Micro-enterprise Assistance Program

Who:

Qualified, non-essential small businesses located in the City of Miami.
Business must have 5 employees or less, including owner

WHAT:

Grants of up to **\$10K** to pay for up to **3 months** of business expenses

WHEN:

Apply beginning **Monday, May 4th at noon**

Small Business Emergency Assistance Loan Program (SBELP)

Who:

Small businesses located in the City of Miami

WHAT:

Loans from **\$10K-20K** to help cover rent, salaries, utilities.
Must retain one job per loan for a low-moderate income employee

Apply beginning **Monday, May 4th at noon**
